CLOTHING LIST – BOARDING GIRLS

All clothing must be named with **maroon on white** nametapes, procurable from the School Shop.

Formal Uniform

- Regulation grey skirt (calf length) (x2)
- Regulation long sleeved blouse (x3)
- Regulation black jacket
- Regulation School tie
- Regulation black leather lace up shoes
- Black pantyhose (colour: nearly black)

Summer Uniform

- Regulation black culottes: just above the knee (x2)
- Regulation black jersey
- Regulation grey blouse (x3)
- Black flat dress sandals (as per samples)

Winter Uniform

- Skirt, blouse, jersey, and shoes (as for Formal Uniform)
- Black pantyhose (heavy)

Sports Uniform

- Swimming costume: one piece
- Regulation Harington PE shirt
- Regulation black PE shorts
- Regulation tracksuit (as required by Sports Code)
- Regulation Harington rugby jersey (optional)
- Regulation Harington singlet (optional)
- Regulation Harington cap
- Sports shoes and socks

Additional Personal Items

- Bedding: own duvet and pillows (sheets and pillow cases are provided)
- Nightwear & dressing gown
- Towels: bath and swimming
- Mufti clothing
- Underwear
- Facecloths
- Toiletries
- Umbrella
- Coffee mug
- Slippers/scuffs
- Shoe cleaning kit
- Notice board pins, Blu-Tac
- Laptop/computer (optional)
- Stereo/iPod (optional) with headphones
- Soft toys, posters, photos, a pot plant, etc, to make your room feel and homely
- A personal 'treasure' to speak about when we have our "getting to know you" session

NAMING OF CLOTHING & FOOTWEAR

Clothing

- All clothing must be **clearly** marked with a student's name. Woven, sew-on nametapes are recommended and can be ordered through the School Shop.
- **Nametapes** should be in the **House colour**, or sewn onto bias binding in the House colour, to help Laundry staff with identification:
 - Harington: Maroon
- For ease of identification, **please attach nametapes** as follows:
 - To shorts: at the centre rear of the waistband (inside).
 - To shirts and other tops: inside the collar at the back of the neck.
 - To duvet covers and pillow cases: at a corner, along an outside edge.
 - To towels: at a corner.
- Boarders should have an extra supply of nametapes that can be left with the House Matron for the occasional garment purchased from the School Shop during term.
- Consideration needs to be given to the type of fabric from which non-uniform items (such as mufti) are made: **wash-and-wear clothing is most suitable**.
- Items sent to the School Laundry are washed in warm/hot water and dried in tumble driers. For this reason the Laundry does **not** wash black School jerseys, which should be either dry cleaned or washed at home.

Footwear

- Please ensure that all footwear is clearly and indelibly named. It should be clearly marked under the tongue (e.g. using twink) with the owner's name, and on the sole just in front of the heel.
